Jesus, God's Son: Nothing's Impossible with Him

Martin Lifer/ FPC Starkville/ December 17, 2023/ Luke 1:35-37 & 9:7-17

Who is Jesus to me? My answer directs all my life, responses to all other questions, and eternity.

Part 1 of the Question: WHO is Jesus?

Lk. 9:9 Herod said, "John I beheaded, but WHO is THIS about whom I hear such things?"

"Who then is this?" Lk. 8:25 (also 5:21 & 7:21,49) ← Lk. 9:9→ Lk. 9:20 "Who do you say I am?"

9:7 The apostles' purposeful, powerful gospel Word & deeds prompt questions → THE Q Do my Christian life & witness 1) perplex evil ones & 2) lead people to ask Q.s → THE Q?

Two miracles recorded in ALL 4 gospels: 9:10-17 Multiplying Bread-loaves & Fish to Feed 5,000+: "men" plus women, children, 12 = Jesus' Most Massive Public Miracle AND Climax of His "Galilean-Stage Ministry" 9:10-11 Apostles' Report; Retreat interrupted; Jesus welcomes crowds, teaching & healing.

9:12-15 Day-end dilemma; Apostles' concern & direction to Jesus; Jesus' direction to them. My dilemmas and Jesus? Do I direct Him based on my power or seek His direction & power?

9:16-17 Greater than Moses & Elisha/Elijah, God's Son Creates Food & Feeds All (Crowds + 12)

Moses, Elijah & Elisha were merely servants & "shadows" under the Son, Jesus. Cf. Heb. 8:5

- "Nothing is impossible with God" Lk. 1:37
- 2) Jesus is "the Son of God" Lk. 1:35
- ∴ 3) Nothing is impossible with Jesus! See, e.g., Feeding 5,000+ and Resurrection from death
