



Herod the Great ("King of the Jews," "friend of Romans") & his educated-in-Rome son Antipas

Jesus, God's Son & Bethlehem-born "son" of David (the king) & of Abraham ("friend of God")

Bethlehem (Beit Lechem) =

Bethsaida = House of Fishing.../House of Hunting/ Pursuit & Provision of Food

Lord's Banquet - "Why do you spend your money for *what's* **not bread** [lechem], your wages for *what does* **not satisfy?** Truly hear Me, and eat *what is* **good**, and delight your soul in **abundance**." *Isa.* 55:2 "Blessed are you who hunger now, because you will be **satisfied**." *Lk.* 6:21

Lk. 9:9 - "Who is THIS about whom I hear such things?" And he was seeking to see Him.9:11- Our King a) permits interruptions, b) welcomes people from all backgrounds,
