





Am I Saved? Ask Jesus, Not Friends

Martin Lifer/ FPC Starkville/ January 28, 2024/ Luke 9:35, 20:37-38 & 23:39-43; Rom. 2:28-29 & 10:9-13

Dying man professing faith in Jesus, calling on His Name: Saved or sentenced to Hell?

Am I saved? Ask Jesus! Look to Christ ______
"This is my Son, the Chosen. Listen to Him!"/ Jesus was found Alone Lk. 9:35-36

Jesus mandated Baptism & the Supper as _______, NT "signs", of believers' inner/spiritual saving union with Him but NOT as 1) conditions precedent to salvation or 2) performances needed to add to the Perfect Person & Work of Christ.

We're **NOT** saved by outward performance or elements (circumcision, water, wine), but by Grace Alone through Faith Alone in Christ alone – to God's Glory alone.

For by ______ you have been saved, through ______. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. Eph. 2:8-9

Only 1 man believed the dying Jesus was Lord of the Coming Kingdom:

"Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." Lk. 23:42

"Truly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in paradise." Lk. 23:43

Abraham, Isaac & Jacob "all live to Him" [risen in Heaven]Lk. 20:37-38 but not baptized!

Abram [not circumcised yet or baptized] believed God's covenant promises. Gen. 15:6; Rom. 4

Abram's justification/salvation was **GIVEN by God** *long before* **Abram's adult circumcision**. *Also,* **Isaac & Jacob** each had **infant circumcision**, long **before their adult faith**.

"born of water and the Spirit" Jn. 3:5 → God's Promise of NT: "I will sprinkle clean Water on you, and you shall be clean,... And I will put My Spirit within you,..." EZER. 36:25-27

For no one is a Jew who is merely one outwardly, nor is circumcision outward and physical. But a Jew is one inwardly, and circumcision is a matter of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the letter. His praise is not from man but from God. Rom. 2:28-29

I thank God that I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius.... (*O yes*, I did baptize also **the Household of Stephanas**. Beyond that, I **do not know whether I baptized anyone else**.) For **Christ did not send me to baptize but to preach the gospel**, and not with ...eloquent wisdom, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power. *1 cor. 1:14-17*

Are you saved? According to the gospel: if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.... For "everyone who calls on the Name of the Lord will be saved." Rom. 10:9-13
